The Keizer Fire District is establishing a Civil Service entrance register for the position of Firefighter/Paramedic with plans to fill **one vacant position** by July 1st, 2021 and potentially others during the life of the list. Individuals filling this position are responsible for providing advanced life support care and transport of sick and injured persons, fire suppression, rescue, public service requests, public education, station/equipment maintenance and other related tasks. Minimum qualifications to apply are: valid and insurable Oregon Class "C" driver's license, State of Oregon Licensed Paramedic, NFPA Firefighter 1, NFPA Driver, and a valid Candidate Physical Abilities Test (CPAT) card. Candidate must also have a minimum of one (1) year firefighter and pre-hospital patient care experience. Within twelve months of employment must obtain NFPA Instructor 1 and NFPA Hazardous Materials Operations. Paramedic program students will be allowed to apply upon receipt of verifiable proof of their program completion date being no later than December 31st, 2021.

The above salary range includes a 10% paramedic pay incentive. The District currently offers the following benefits: sick time, vacation, holidays, health, vision, dental, disability, and life insurance, PERS retirement, medical savings plan, tax deferred medical and child care reimbursement plan, various deferred compensation plan options and education incentives.

Qualified individuals should request an application packet (applicant letter, supplemental questionnaire and employment application) from the Keizer Fire District's business office located at: 661 Chemawa Road N.E. All applications and supplemental questionnaires must be signed and returned or postmarked by 5:00pm on Friday, April 30th, 2021. Applications will NOT be accepted or considered if received or postmarked after this date.

Applicants must complete a National Testing Network FireTEAM examination and have those results submitted to the District by 5:00pm on April 30th, 2021. After screening of the submitted applications and FireTEAM results, up to the top 30 candidates will invited to a three person interview panel, tentatively scheduled for May 20st and 21st, 2021.
